


















- Meeting stakeholders and policy decision makers






Further achievements in 2022



- Joint Case Study of Capacity Allocation rules in case of international disruption ("Joint ICM Case Study") – together with RFCs Baltic-Adriatic, Orient/East-Med and Rhine-Danube
 - → Investigated case: Disruption at Bratislava-Petržalka in January-February 2022
- Language project for simplification of cross-border rail freight led by MÁV finalised – together with RFC Orient/East-Med
 - → Simplification of procedures on Hungarian-Slovak border crossings
- Identification of time windows for longer freight trains on Western Hungarian North-South axis within the CORCAP-project and definition of train paths for longer trains





Further achievements in 2022 (cont.)




- RFC AMBER joining EU-Ukraine Solidarity Lanes in June 2022

Cross border rail freight on RFC AMBER 2019 - 2022




Number of trains per border (source: IMs' national systems)
