






## Traffic development

# 2023 – Adoption of new corridor objectives



- Objective 1: Average planned speed of PaPs (Capacity Mgmt KPI)
- Objective 2: Punctuality at destination (Operational KPI)
- Objective 3: Dwell times in border sections (Operational KPI)
- Objective 4: Number of trains per border (Market KPI)
- <u>Objective 5</u>: Provision of paths with improved parameters (Qualitative KPI)



### Time horizons for objectives



#### **Time horizons for target values:**

Short-term: 2024

Medium-term: 2028 (5 years)

#### **Reference value:**

- 2023 or latest available data before
- Where appropriate an average value of several years may be chosen
- For the purpose of monitoring of the objectives a selection (e.g. of paths/sections/trains) may be chosen





# Corridor objectives with target values



Objective	Target 2024	Target 2028 (5 years)
Average planned speed of PaPs	+12,5 %	+25 %
Punctuality at destination (<= 30 min.)	+ 5 %	+ 12 %
Dwell times in border sections	- 10 %	- 25 %
Number of trains per border	+ 3 %	+ 10 %
Provision of paths with improved para-meters, e.g. train length or train weight	6 paths	10 paths

# Further achievements in 2023/24



• Identification of time windows for longer freight trains on Western Hungarian North-South axis within the CORCAP-project and definition of train paths for longer trains



### **Implementation Plan update**



- Main milestones
- 1 First update and approval of draft by the MaBo → May 2023
- 2 Submission to the RAG-TAG and to the ExBo and consultation of applicants for commenting → July 2023
- 3 Discussion and incorporation of the comments + MaBo approval → December 2023
- 3 Publication → January 2024





#### **Update of RFC AMBER Transport Market Study (TMS)**



- Ongoing final draft expected soon (June 2024)
- Harmonized approach by all eleven Rail Freight Corridors
- Supported by external consultant contracted by RailNetEurope (RNE)
- Consultations of RAG-TAG-Members and stakeholders during second half of 2024
- Target date for finalization: December 2024



# New activity launched



- Analysis of operations at border crossing Hodoš/Őriszentpéter (SI-HU border) ongoing
- Objective: Identify prospects for improvement and improve procedures

# Outlook




- RFCs adapting to new European Transport Corridors (ETCs) based on revised TEN-T-Regulation (expected to enter into force in June/July 2024)
- RFCs Baltic-Adriatic and Amber to form the core of one of the nine ETCs
- Customer benefits
  - More route options
  - Higher resilience, due to re-routing options within one corridor
  - RFC offer "in one hand", instead of larger overlapping sections
  - Extension to Croatia
  - Joint RAG-TAG-meetings
- Close coordination started between Members of RFCs Baltic-Adriatic,
   Amber and HŽ Infra for the setting up of the new corridor governance
