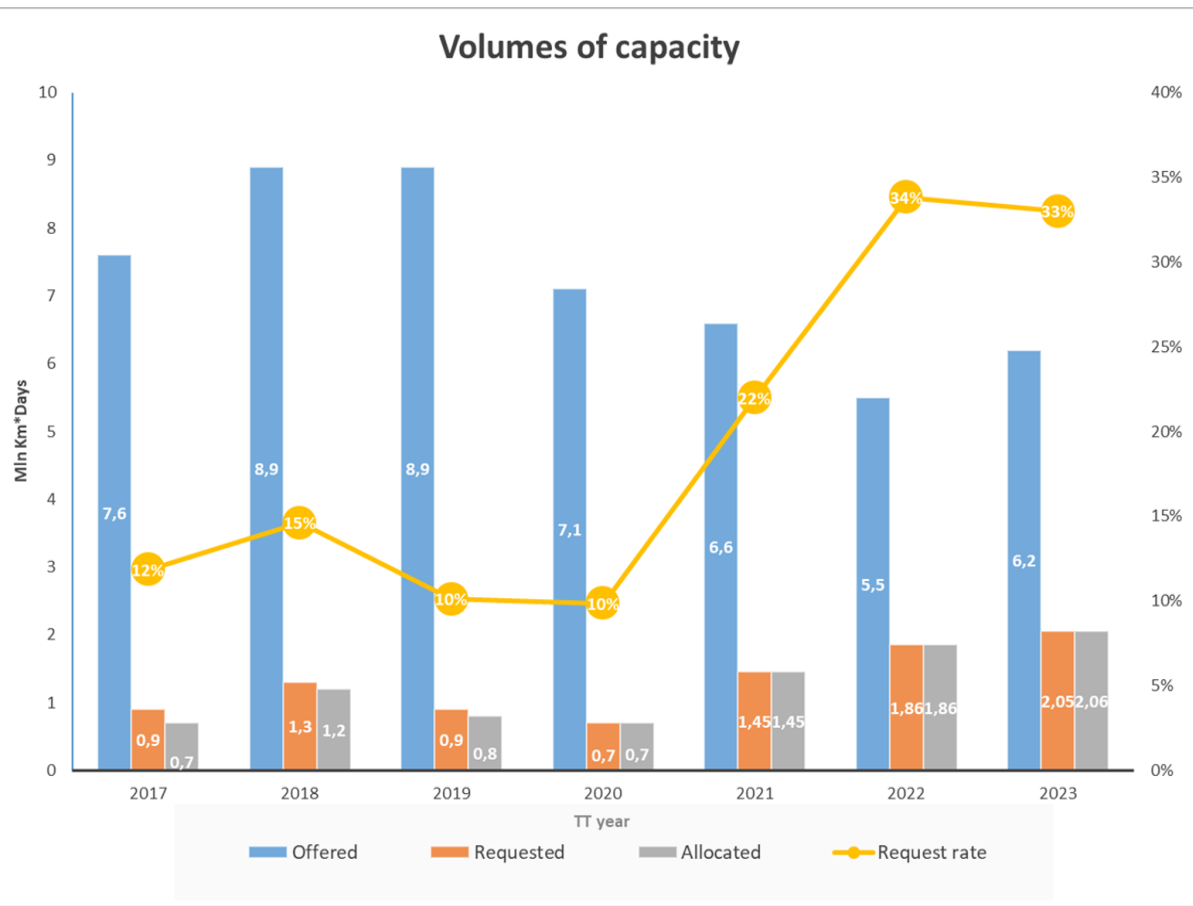

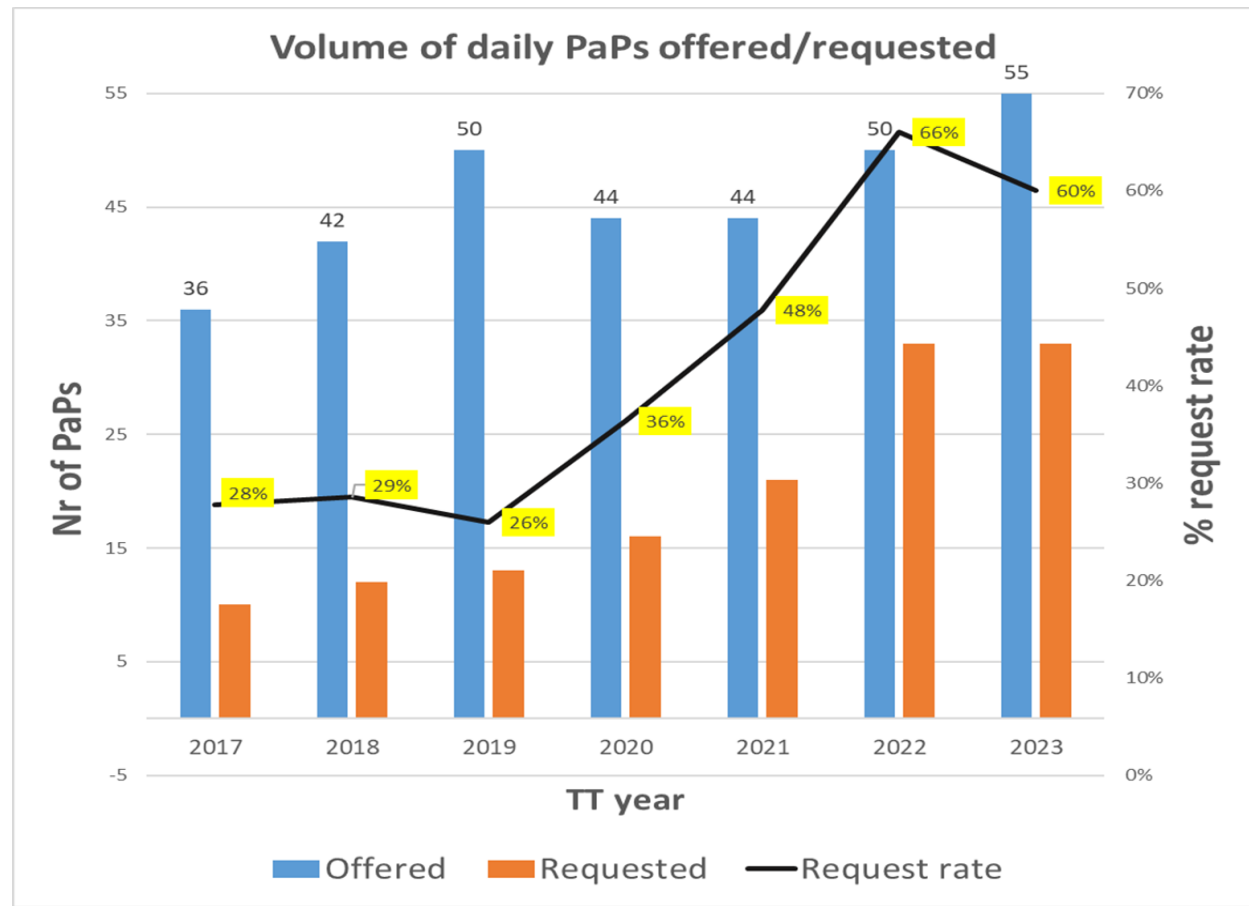
# Corridor capacity offer KPIs

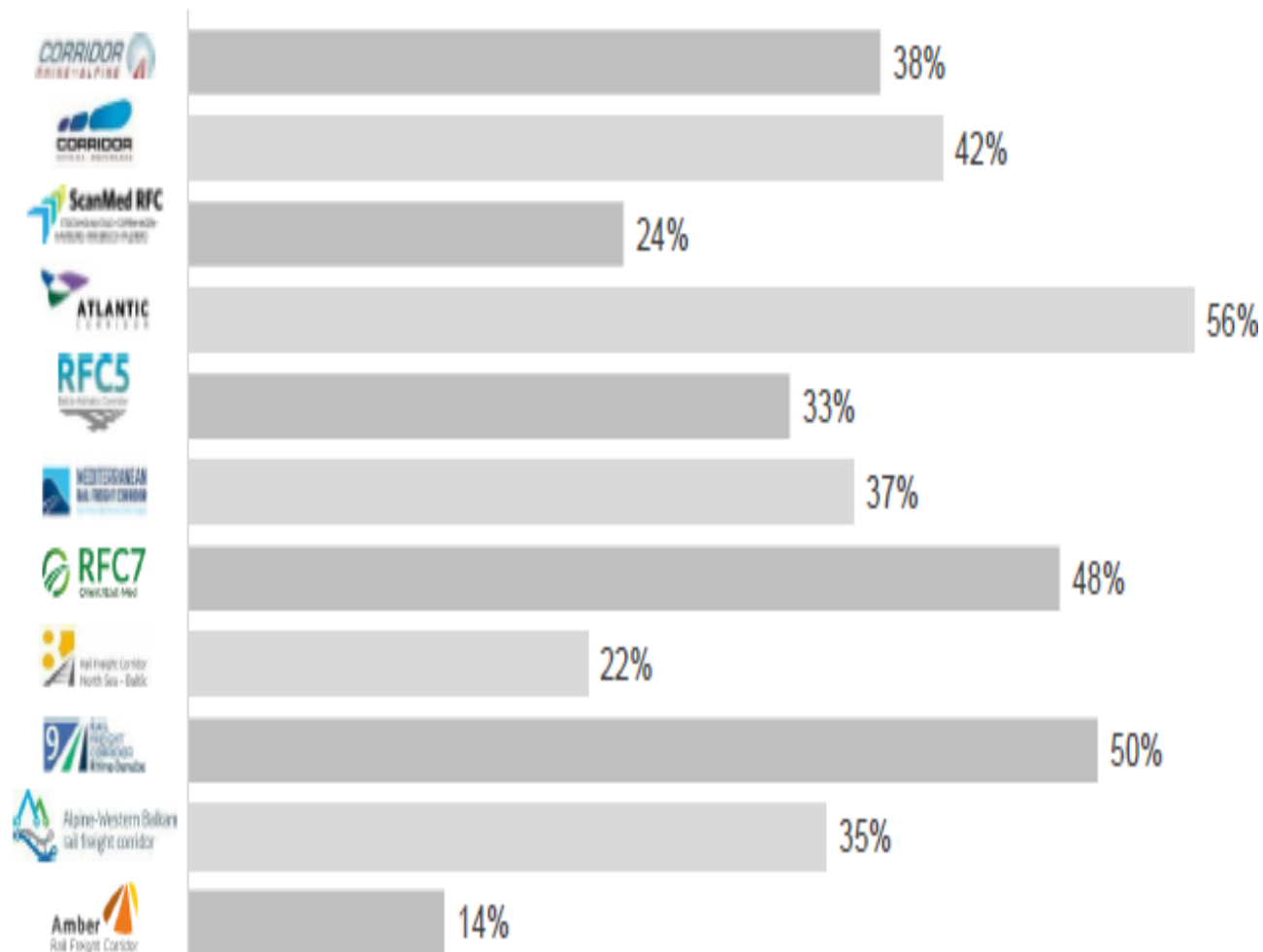
Trend of PaPs – quantity

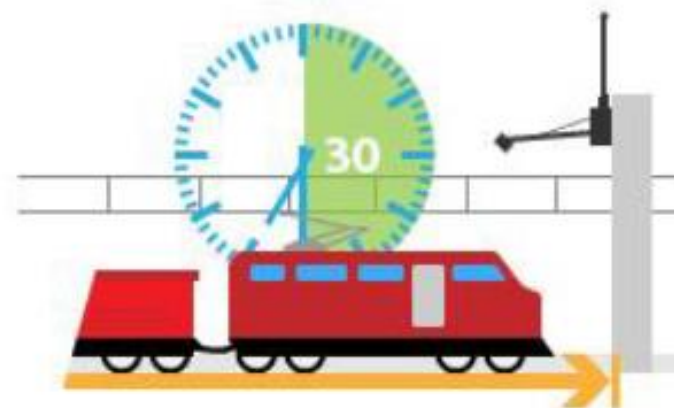
